Another feature *The Lutheran* offers is the ten issues a year of *The Little Lutheran*. This separate subscription is a great way for parents, grandparents, godparents, Sunday schools, or anyone else with young children in their lives. *The Little Lutheran* is designed to help children six and under learn about God's love for them and the world in which they live.

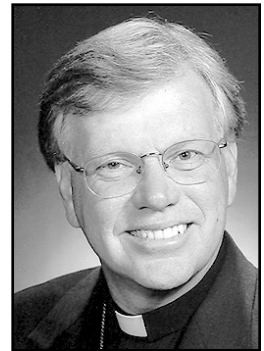
